

The Secretariat of the ACP Group of States has a vacancy for the post of Expert in charge of Fisheries (**Grade P3**).

Applications must be accompanied by a complete curriculum vitae, copies of diplomas, certificates and any other document testifying to the competence and professional experience of the candidates.

Candidates must be nationals of Member States of the ACP Group and must therefore attach a copy of their valid passport as proof of nationality.

It is to be noted that only short-listed candidates will be contacted.

MAIN DUTIES

1. Promotion of the visibility of the Fisheries mechanism through various tools, including the setting up and management of a website and the organization of meetings with relevant stakeholders;
2. Formulation of an implementation plan for the Resolutions of the ACP Ministers in charge of Fisheries;
3. Provision of regular statements of actions implemented in relation to the Resolutions of the ACP Ministers in charge of Fisheries;
4. Provision of advice in order to avoid duplication of projects, by updating the “Desk Study on the Main Donors Support to the Fisheries and Aquaculture Sector in ACP Countries”;
5. Establishment of a framework for the ACP Fisheries Mechanism to monitor/evaluate fisheries development on the international arena and provide briefing sessions monthly to the ACP Working Group on Fisheries.

6. Analysis of EU papers on fisheries and determining its effect and impact on the ACP states, and advising the ACP Group accordingly.
7. Analysis of the negotiations related to fisheries that take place at the World Trade Organisation and advice on the effects that such negotiations could have on the ACP Group.
8. Formulation of programmes for the development of fresh water and marine culture in the ACP Group and seek solutions for their financing.

REQUISITE QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A master's degree or equivalent in Fisheries Economics, Fisheries Management, Aquaculture or an equivalent subject.
2. At least 5 years of experience in the fisheries sector, three of them being with an international organisation.
3. An excellent command of English or French or Portuguese or Spanish. A working knowledge of Spanish or Portuguese will be an added advantage.
4. Must be computer literate.

APPOINTING AUTHORITY

Staff members of the Professional and General Services categories are appointed by the Secretary General on the recommendations of the Recruitment Advisory Committee chaired by the Assistant Secretary-General, Head of the Department of Administration, Finance and Human Resources.
