TITLE	Preparation of Draft Trade Remedies Laws compatible with the WTO agreements on Anti-Dumping, Subsidies and Countervailing measures, and Safeguards
Applicant	Uganda - Ministry of Trade, Tourism and Industry
Duration of the Project	The intended commencement date is March 2012 and the period of implementation of the contract will be 5 months from this date
Purpose of the action	<p><i>The overall objective</i> is two-fold:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To prepare Trade Remedies Measures through amendment of legislations or drafting of new laws where none exist. - To prepare regulations establishing the Investigation Authority
Expertise Required	The assignment calls for two key experts conversant with the WTO laws on ADP, SCM and SG. The experts should also be knowledgeable on how to prepare rules and regulations to establish an Investigation Authority.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Review of existing laws and regulations that address trade remedies, including the relevant provisions of the EAC Customs Protocol and COMESA; ii. Carry out internal consultations with relevant government officials and private sector; iii. Draft domestic laws on Antidumping, Subsidies and Countervailing Measures, and safeguard measures; iv. Prepare draft on rules and regulations governing the establishment of an Investigation Authority; v. Hold a stakeholders workshop to validate the drafts (4 days) ; vi. Study tour (5 days) coordinated by Key Expert 2 for 5 officials to South Africa to learn how the Investigation Authority functions
